Registration Procedures

In order to register your scout into Troop 14, the following are necessary:

- Read through the Introduction, Volunteer Jobs and Safe Haven pages included in this booklet
 - Complete the following forms:
 - The Scout Application
 - The Scout Class 1 medical form (on back of application)
 - *Be sure to remove the carbon before writing on the back of the form*
 - Troop 14 Parental Data form
 - Parent/Guardian Troop Resource form for each parent
- Prepare a check made out to '**BSA Troop 14**' for \$35 for each scout being registered.
 - Registration fees include Boy's Life subscription, annual dues, one Troop 14 tee-shirt. *(If your Scout is already registered and receiving the Boys Life magazine – registration is \$25)*
- Please look over the volunteer assignments on the "Troop 14 Volunteer Jobs" page. These are ways you can help Troop 14 make you boy's scouting experience something great!
- Be sure your Scout has an official Boy Scout Handbook and the full Boy Scout uniform as described in the "Introduction to Troop 14" pages
- Scout and parents read and sign the "I agree" form

- Bring all of the above to the Registration Chairman and the Scoutmaster at a regular Troop 14 meeting or a scheduled meeting.
